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# Supporting Children When Parenting Apart



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**The Program:**

The program will help unmarried or divorcing parents in understanding and responding to the needs of your children. Guidelines on cooperative parenting and keeping children "out of the middle" will be presented. Tools to help you have a successful co-parenting relationship will be provided.

**Dates and Location:**

The program consists of two (2 hour) sessions, 4 hours total. Call the UW-Extension Office at 920-388-7137 for the upcoming class schedule. The program is conducted at the Kewaunee County Administration Center, UW-Extension Office, 810 Lincoln St., Kewaunee, WI.

**Cost and Pre-Registration:**

The cost of the program is \$25 (cash or check). Credit or debit cards are not accepted. Payment must be received with the registration form before the first session.

**Attendance:**

The Kewaunee County Circuit Court requires all divorcing parents and some unmarried parents to complete the program. It is in the best interest of your children that you use positive strategies to support them. Research shows that cooperative parenting learned through a program such as this provides a good environment for children, and it reduces re-litigation.

**Certificate of Completion:**

Upon completion, a Certificate of Completion will be sent to the Kewaunee County Clerk of Court. A copy will be provided to the Family Court Commissioner and to you.


