Kewaunee County to Participate in Recycling Event with Proceeds Going to Local Food Pantry

KEWAUNEE, WI – Kewaunee County aims to help stock the shelves at the LC Food Pantry, by taking part in an upcoming electronics recycling event hosted by the Bank of Luxemburg.

On Saturday, November 5th, Kewaunee County will be dropping off a truckload of 55 PCs, 10 printers, as well as numerous computer keyboards and mice at the Bank of Luxemburg branch in Casco, according to Kewaunee County IT Director Ross Loining. “This is five years of outdated and unusable electronics. The recycling event is a win, win for everyone, our donation is helping out those who need assistance with getting food on the table,” said Loining.

The electronics recycling event on Saturday is open to the public and is scheduled from 8:00 a.m. – Noon at the Bank of Luxemburg branch, 100 Old Orchard Drive, Casco.

And, for every filled pallet of electronics, Cyber Green LLC of Green Bay, will donate \$10 to the LC Food Pantry at Holy Trinity Church, 510 Church Avenue, Casco. The LC Food Pantry is open the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of each month from 12:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. and the 2nd and 4th Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.
