## **Kewaunee County Hosts 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Holiday Memorial Food Drive**

KEWAUNEE, WI – Kewaunee County Human Services is asking for a hand with helping local residents in need, through the 4<sup>th</sup> Annual “Giving for Sara” Food Drive.

The holiday fundraiser is in the memory of Sara Malay, who was serving as the Aging Services Unit Director for Kewaunee County, when she unexpectedly passed away on October 7, 2013.

In the last three years, Kewaunee County Human Services has collected and donated more than four tons of food to the Kewaunee County Food Pantry in Sara’s memory.

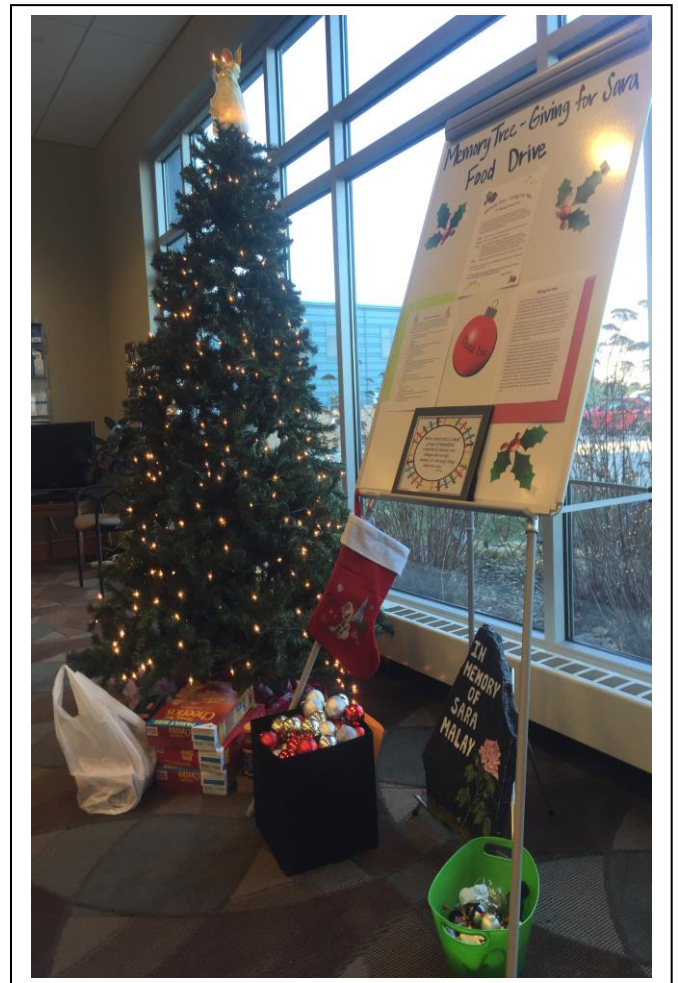
