Kewaunee County Reminds Residents about Primary for Board of Supervisors Race

KEWAUNEE, WI – Kewaunee County residents in the Town of Lincoln and the Town of Franklin, who are eligible to vote, have a ballot to cast on Tuesday, February 20, 2018.

The Kewaunee County Board of Supervisors race has a primary in both District 2 and District 10. Each district has three candidates seeking the seats being vacated by Supervisor Larry Kirchman, District 2 and Supervisor Ron Paider, District 10. The top two candidates of each race will move on to the Tuesday, April 3, 2018 general election.
