Kewaunee County Offers FREE Skin Cancer Screening

KEWAUNEE, WI – It's estimated that skin cancer strikes one in five people in their lifetime, and the Kewaunee County Public Health Department is partnering with Prevea to increase awareness in the community.

The public is invited to get examined for skin cancer for FREE on Saturday, April 7, 2018 at the Prevea Luxemburg Health Center, 101 School Creek Trail, Luxemburg from 9AM-NOON.

Medical professionals will be offering spot checks, discussing the signs of skin cancer and sharing advice on how to protect your skin.

"The single best way to protect yourself is to use sunscreen any time that you're outdoors," says Cindy Kinnard, RN, Director of Kewaunee County Public Health Department. "The sun is out year round, so we need UV protection in spring, summer, fall and winter too."
