Voters Elect New Kewaunee County Board of Supervisors

KEWAUNEE, WI – Kewaunee County had 5,483 registered voters cast a ballot on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 in the spring election either in person or via absentee.

Unofficial results in the Kewaunee County Board of Supervisors race show that 12 incumbents will serve another two-year term on the board along with 8 new supervisors, as 14 out of 14 units have reported results to the Kewaunee County Clerk's Office.

The 20-seat board had nine contested races and two vacant seats in this election.

The vacant seat for District 5 in the Village of Luxemburg could be filled by non-registered write-in candidate Kent Treml of the Village of Luxemburg, who had 6 votes, pending the nomination is accepted. If not, the Kewaunee County Board of Supervisor Chair will appoint a representative.

In District 13, Kim Kroll, a resident of the Town of Luxemburg, who was a registered write-in candidate, has been elected with 50 votes to serve the Town of Casco, Town of West Kewaunee and Town of Luxemburg as supervisor.

Meanwhile, a tie in District 10 in the Town of Franklin could be decided by a drawdown, if verification of total votes by the Kewaunee County Board of Canvassers is unchanged with 102 votes each for candidates Thomas Cretney and John Wochos.

The Kewaunee County Board of Canvassers will certify numbers on Tuesday, April 10, 2018 starting at 9AM at the Kewaunee County Administration Center, 810 Lincoln Street, Kewaunee. Unofficial election results are posted online at www.kewauneeco.org.

The Kewaunee County Board of Supervisors will meet on Tuesday, April 24, 2018 at 5:30PM for an organizational session, which will decide the seat of the Kewaunee County Board of Supervisors Chair, as well as committee appointments.
