Kewaunee County Transportation Program Seeking Volunteers

KEWAUNEE, WI – The Kewaunee County Department of Human Services is looking for volunteers who can help give senior citizens and residents with disabilities a sense of independence paired with some good company for appointments, shopping and more.

In 2017, the Transportation Program in Kewaunee County provided over 1,300 rides for residents through the use of volunteers.

These trained drivers use their own vehicles and are reimbursed for mileage, unless a wheelchair accessible van is requested, in which that vehicle is provided by Kewaunee County.

Volunteers must undergo screening, possess a valid driver's license and have completed orientation of the Transportation Program.

Transportation is scheduled Monday-Friday 8AM-4:30PM, excluding holidays.
