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Kewaunee County Public Health Department Suggests Early Vaccinations

KEWAUNEE, WI – Summer is a busy time, but the Kewaunee County Public Health Department is suggesting that parents take a moment to get their child or children vaccinated before everyone makes a mad dash to the doctor's office in August.

"It sometimes can be really difficult to get a last minute appointment, so having vaccinations done early can give you peace of mind well before the new school year begins," says Cindy Kinnard, RN and Director of the Kewaunee County Public Health Department.

In 2017, the Kewaunee County Public Health Department had administered a total of 1,013 vaccines to children in Kewaunee County.

"If parents want more information on certain vaccinations and what's needed and when, we're here to help," adds Kinnard.
