Kewaunee County Seeks Feedback on Investing in Broadband Internet Access

KEWAUNEE, WI – An investment into broadband internet access is expected to be part of the next Kewaunee County budget. But, before a financial figure is allocated for 2019, the County wants to hear from residents through Polco, an online public survey system used by Kewaunee County to gather input on local issues.

“We have \$40,000 in the form of a Broadband Expansion Grant, but we need to invest much more to make a noticeable difference for residents and business owners who want and need high-speed internet access,” says Scott Feldt, Kewaunee County Administrator. “The public needs to tell us what they think Kewaunee County should commit to broadband for an internet connection that meets industry standards.”

Should Kewaunee County invest money into broadband internet access, if so how much?

- Less than \$500,000*
- \$500,000 to \$1 million*
- \$1 million or greater*
- None, Kewaunee County should not invest in broadband internet access.*
