SIREN MAINTENANCE FOR POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT SIRENS IN KEWAUNEE COUNTY

(LUXEMBURG) – During the dates of September 3 through September 14, 2018 (excluding the Labor Day Holiday) Point Beach Nuclear Plant will be performing maintenance on a number of sirens within the ten miles of the plant that are in Manitowoc and Kewaunee Counties.

During siren maintenance, residents may hear actual siren activations for approximately one to three minutes, and notice activity going on and around the siren sites.

Performance of this routine maintenance helps to ensure that sirens in the county work well, should they need to be activated.

During the duration of the testing, if individuals have concerns and are unsure whether or not the activities may be related to the maintenance, call (920) 845-9700 or (920) 388-3100 for verification.
