Kewaunee County Emergency Personnel to Train for Industrial Incident

LUXEMBURG, WI – The sound of sirens, sight of squad cars, fire trucks and emergency response personnel should not alarm Village of Luxemburg residents this weekend.

Kewaunee County Emergency Management and community partners will be simulating an industrial type incident on Saturday, October 20, 2018 on 4th Street, in the parking lot of Prevea Luxemburg Health Center and at the Luxemburg Community Fire Department.

“The purpose of this exercise is to practice procedures and identify areas that need improvement if an incident should occur,” says Tracy Nollenberg. “It’s not often that we expect to get a call for something of this nature, but it’s always good to be prepared.”

There will be a partial closure of 4th Street around the time of the exercise from 8AM to 1PM in the area of State Highway 54 to the Kewaunee County Fairgrounds. The public will have access to open businesses and those reporting to work will be able to get to and from their place of employment.

Specifics on the industrial type incident that will be practiced are being kept confidential. We ask that the public does not interfere with the exercise or interrupt authorized personnel. Those in violation of this request will be asked to leave the premises.
