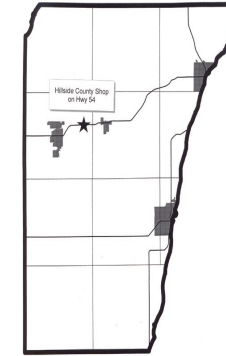

It's an opportunity for farmers, ag businesses and households to dispose of banned, damaged, expired, unwanted chemicals, pesticides, household wastes and dry medications in an environmentally safe manner.

Who can participate?

The collection is open to ALL Kewaunee County residents. Ag collection includes dairy, livestock, grain, fruit, vegetable, Christmas tree farms, nurseries and greenhouses located in Kewaunee County.

How much will it cost to participate?

This collection is a FREE service provided by grants received from Wisconsin DATCP and Wisconsin DNR.
