Unknown Chemicals

Unknown chemicals in less than 50 pound or 5 gallon quantities will be accepted.

Pre-registration recommended.

Kewaunee County reserves the right to reject any materials brought to Hazardous Waste Collection that do not meet the reasonable intent of the program.

- Enamel/Lead/Oil based paint
- Thinner
- Turpentine

Medications

- pills or capsules emptied into clear plastic bag (No pill containers accepted)
- NO LIQUIDS, CREAMS, SUPPOSITORIES OR GELS**

Ag Chemicals

- Acid Washes
- Engine cleaners
- Solvents
- Wood treatment, etc.
- Veterinary supplies

Ammunition

- All types

Fire Extinguishers

- A, B, C, D, & K

Automotive

- Transmission Fluid
- Degreasers
- Brake Fluid

Lawn and Garden

- Fungicides
- Rodenticides

Unacceptable Items

- Compressed gas cylinders
- Freon 11 and 12
- Infectious and biological wastes

- Explosives and fireworks
- Radioactives, including smoke alarms
- Contaminated Soil
- Tires
- No Waste Oil

What is Hazardous Waste Collection?

Kewaunee County Hazardous Waste Collection will give farmers, ag businesses and household an opportunity to dispose of unused, damaged, cancelled, banned, or unwanted chemicals, pesticides, household wastes and unwanted, unused or expired medications in an environmentally safe manner.

Who can participate?

Hazardous Waste Collection is open to all residents of Kewaunee County. Businesses, industries and institutions cannot participate. Ag collection includes all dairy, livestock, grain, fruit, vegetable and christmas tree farms as well as nurseries and greenhouses located in Kewaunee County.

How much will it cost to participate?

Hazardous Waste Collection is a FREE service provided to Kewaunee County residents by grants received from Wisconsin DATCP and Wisconsin Dept. of Natural Resources.


